**SUBJECT: DIRECTIVE 2022-06
MANDATORY ATTENDANCE OF OPERATIONAL BRIEFINGS**

This directive provides direction to commissioned personnel regarding the mandatory attendance of operational briefings for high-risk operations.

All planned operations shall have an Operations Plan and an operational briefing. If another agency is running a planned multi-agency operation and fails to hold a briefing, an NMSP supervisor shall be notified. The NMSP supervisor, or designee, shall obtain all relevant information and ensure that all NMSP personnel receive an operational briefing.

An NMSP supervisor has the authority to refuse NMSP involvement in an operation if any part of the operation violates NMSP policies, procedures, or directives.

All personnel involved in the planned operation shall attend the operational briefing. Any personnel that do not attend the briefing for a planned operation shall not participate in the operation.

Officers who respond to emergency situations shall be briefed with as much information as possible as they arrive at the scene.
