

## **ORGANIZATIONAL AFFILIATE - OMAHA POLICE FOUNDATION**

### **PREAMBLE:**

The Omaha Police Foundation of Omaha is a non-profit entity that works in partnership with the Omaha Police Department to develop, implement, and fund innovative programs and to assist in the acquisition of technology upgrades and equipment.

### **POLICY:**

It is the policy of the Omaha Police Department (OPD) to recognize the Omaha Police Foundation (OPF) as an affiliate organization. As such the OPF is authorized to utilize the branding symbols of the OPD.

### **PROCEDURE:**

#### **I. Requests for Funding**

- A. Requests for funding from the OPF are prioritized by the Chief of Police, who makes a formal recommendation to the OPF's Board of Directors. In order to facilitate the prioritization process, the following procedures are to be followed:
  - 1. All requests for funding from the OPF are to be forwarded to the Professional Oversight Bureau (POB) Deputy Chief.
    - a. Every request must include a description, cost, and justification for the program or equipment.
    - b. Every request must also include an impact statement, indicating how this program or equipment acquisition will benefit the OPD and the citizens of Omaha.
  - 2. The POB Deputy Chief will catalog the requests by Bureau and submit them to the Chief of Police for review.
  - 3. The Chief of Police will determine what recommendation will be made to the OPF.
  - 4. OPD employees will not directly contact any OPF Board Member or the OPF's Managing Consulting Firm without authorization from the Chief of Police.

#### **II. OPD Branding**

- A. OPF is authorized to use OPD logos, badges, and images.
  - 1. OPF leadership shall contact the OPD Public Information Office for current logos, badges, and images as needed.
