What is Premise Health?

What is a member?

Members are what we call our patients who are eligible to use a center operated by Premise Health. It's not a membership that you have to pay for or apply to be a part of. You're simply considered a member once your employer has partnered with us to provide your health and wellness services.

Where is the center located?

Premise Health Center is conveniently located near your campus at 10006 Auburn Park Drive, Fort Wayne, IN 46825.

What services are provided at the center?

Who can use the center?

Eligible members (ages 2+) may use the Premise Health Center as part of your PHP benefits.

What does it cost?

Services are available for a \$10 copay on the Physicians Health Plan. If you are on the High-Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) or Health Savings Account (HSA), you pay \$35 per visit until your deductible is met.



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What are the center's hours?

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. Wednesday, 10 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Is the center operated by PHP employees?

No, the center is staffed and operated by Premise Health. It is managed just like any other licensed medical office in the community.

What type of medical staff will work at the center?

Premise Health has recruited a high-quality team of dedicated healthcare professionals to staff and manage your wellness center. The team includes a medical director, nurse practitioner, licensed social worker, nurses, medical assistants and a receptionist.

Can my medical records be shared between the center and my primary care provider (PCP)?

You can request that your PCP share your records with Premise Health Center by completing your provider's record sharing process. Additionally, you may request for Premise Health to share your records with your PCP or specialist.
