Authority

This policy is issued pursuant to Sheriff David J. Lucero's directive in which authority to manage and direct all activities connected with the Oath of Office is delegated to the Undersheriff.

Purpose

This policy provides guidance for the Oath of Office to be administered to members of the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office.

Oath Of Office Policy

All personnel, prior to assuming sworn-officer status, shall be administered and subsequently abide by an oath of office to enforce the laws of the county and city of Pueblo, State of Colorado and United States of America, and to uphold the constitutions of the state of Colorado and United States of America. <1.1.1>

Authority

All sworn members of this office, by virtue of their oath to office, C.R.S.30-10-516 <http://www.lexisnexis.com/hottopics/colorado/> and the United States Constitution reserving law enforcement powers to the states, shall have the power and authority, and it shall be their duty, to enforce the laws of the county and city of Pueblo, State of Colorado and the United States of America. <1.2.1>
