## 16.3 Part-Time Officer Program

### A. Purpose

To establish a Police Part-Time Unit comprised of AZ POST certified law enforcement officers who have been appointed by the Chief of Police to supplement the overall quality of law enforcement services within the Town of Paradise Valley.

#### B. Definitions

- 1. **Part-Time Officer**. A certified AZ POST police officer who is a compensated, member of the Paradise Valley Police Department officer program.
- 2. **Solo** *Officer*: A *Paradise Valley Police Department* Part-Time Officer who has satisfactorily completed the *Department's* Field Training Program and all other pre- and post-academy required training, and is authorized to perform law enforcement duties without the direct supervision of a Full-Time *officer* and works and operates a patrol vehicle alone. Solo *officer* status *will* be approved by the *Part-Time Program Coordinator*.
- 3. **Part-Time Program Coordinator**: The Part-Time Program Coordinator *will* report to the Patrol Commander. The Part-Time Program Coordinator *will* be the FTO Sergeant.

#### C. Procedure

- 1. Organization: The Police Part-Time Unit has an organizational component within the structure of the Police *Department*. The Unit comes directly under the command of the *Chief of Police* and *will* be supervised by the *Part-Time Program Coordinator*.
- 2. Part-Time Assignments: Part-Time officers will be assigned to directly assist full-time personnel both in day-to-day delivery of law enforcement services and during emergencies.
  - a) Part-Time officers will be assigned to work under the direction of a Field Training Officer until they have completed the Department's Field Training Program and obtained solo officer status.

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- b) Once a *Part-Time officer* obtains solo *officer* status, they *will* be allowed to work and operate a patrol vehicle alone. At the discretion of the *on duty supervisor*, the solo *Part-Time officer may* be assigned to ride with another *officer*.
- c) While working in an operational capacity, *Part-Time officers will* be accountable to and report to the *on duty supervisor*.
- d) To maintain a position as a *Part-Time officer*, a *Part-Time officer must* work a minimum of 24 hours per calendar quarter (96 hours annually).
- D. Selection Criteria: Part-Time officers are paid and must meet the same selection criteria as full-time officers, including educational requirements. They must be AZ POST certified peace officers. Each Part-Time officer must complete (or have completed) a Field Training program and meet all required annual training, policy reviews and proficiency testing (including use of force and firearm and other weapon proficiency) required of a certified peace officer. The Police Chief shall make all appointments for the position of Part-Time Police Officer. All Part-Time officers serve at the pleasure of the Chief and may be terminated at any time by the Police Chief, without notice or appeal.

### E. Training:

- 1. Part-Time officers are trained to perform the same duties as full-time police officers and are required to comply with all Department General Orders and policies, rules and procedures.
- 2. Part-Time officers will receive in-service training equivalent to that of full-time officers performing similar functions. However, hours and schedule may vary to accommodate the Part-Time officer's schedule.
- 3. Part-Time officers will be trained in applicable areas including use of force policies and tested for firearms proficiency.

### F. Uniforms and Equipment

 All necessary and required supplies and types of equipment that are issued to Full-Time officers shall be issued to Part-Time officers, shall remain the Department's property and shall be returned upon request of the Department or

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separation from the *Part-Time officer* program. *Part-Time officers shall* wear and be subject to the same uniform requirements as Full-Time *officers*.

- 2. Ballistic vests *will* be issued at the time equipment is issued to the *Part-Time* officer.
- 3. Part-Time officers will be equipped with their necessary equipment and adhere to PVPD uniform policies when on duty acting in a Part-Time officer capacity.

### G. Restrictions to Duty

- 1. Part-Time officers are responsible to follow all Town and PVPD policies and guidelines that are applicable to Full-Time employees.
- 2. General *Orders*: All *Part-Time officers will* be responsible for reading the *Department's Policy Manual and adhering to all policies and procedures.*
- 3. Part-Time officers will receive written authorization from the Chief of Police or designee concerning the successful completion of the required FTO Program and related training prior to the solo operation of a fully marked patrol unit.
- 4. Part-Time officers will be employed by the Paradise Valley Police Department in a paid capacity.
  - a. In the event there are exceptions approved by the *Chief of Police*, the following *will* apply:
    - Part-Time officers who are also employed by the PVPD in a fulltime or part-time civilian position, will adhere to all the same rules and regulations that apply to Town employees.
    - When Part-Time officers are working their normal duty hours as a full-time or part-time civilian employee, they will not act in a Part-Time officer capacity. Be a good witness.
    - Part-Time officers will not wear their police uniforms or equipment (including badge and weapon) while on duty as a full-time or parttime civilian employee. Official police uniforms and equipment will

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only be worn by *Part-Time officers* when acting in the capacity of a *Part-Time officer*.

- 5. Part-Time officers must not be employees in any job, which creates a conflict of interest for the Town of Paradise Valley. If a Part-Time officer becomes employed in a job other than, or in addition to, the one they had when hired, he or she will notify the Part-Time Coordinator as soon as possible, regardless of the job.
- 6. Part-Time officers will be provided with the same coverage as full-time officers with public liability protection equal to that provided for full-time police personnel.

#### H. Evaluations

Each Part-Time officer shall receive a performance evaluation (see GO #35) at least once each year.

#### I. Attendance

- 1. Perform assigned duties for a minimum of 24 hours per calendar quarter (96 hours annually).
- 2. The Chief of Police may waive the required minimum work hours on an individual basis if any of the following exist: the Part-Time officer has specific specialized training in a technical field; for example, computer programming, accident reconstruction, training instructor and/or the Part-Time officer has demonstrated exceptional performance in specialized areas of investigation or management.
- 3. The *Part-Time officer* maintains all training required by *AZ POST*.
- 4. The *Part-Time officer will* complete a monthly memorandum forwarded to the Part-Time Coordinator with a briefing of all duties performed and a detailed accounting of hours worked.
- J. Part-Time officers may work off duty jobs only with the approval of the Police Chief. Part-Time officers will only be eligible for off duty job assignments when no full time police officer is available to work the off duty job.

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
