

71.2 Restraining Prisoners

All persons *arrested* for felony offenses, and those arrested for misdemeanors who are belligerent or combative, who are verbally abusive or otherwise likely to become combative, or who appear likely to cause injury to themselves or others, or whom the *officer* feels it is necessary to restrain, *shall* be handcuffed at the time of *arrest* and remain restrained until confined in jail. Officers should not handcuff or restrain disabled, sick or injured prisoners unless the circumstances dictate otherwise.
