

82.6 Arizona Criminal Justice Information System

- A. The Arizona Criminal Justice Information System (ACJIS) system is a series of databases maintained by the Arizona Department of Public Safety for the use of specific law enforcement and criminal justice personnel. The information in the database may be accessed only for law enforcement purposes and may be shared only with other law enforcement personnel, and only for law enforcement purposes. To directly access the database, an employee must first be certified as a Terminal Operator by DPS.
- B. Information from *ACJIS shall* not be disseminated to any person not authorized to receive the information, including *employees* or the public.
- C. Agencies that participate in ACJIS and federal criminal justice information systems must comply with the rules and successfully complete the FBI CJIS Division triennial audit.
