## 403.9 <u>PURSUIT FORM (TPD 996B):</u>

All officers involved in a vehicle pursuit will complete the pursuit form (TPD 996B). Involvement shall include but are not limited to: Officers who initiate a pursuit, assisting units, officers who parallel a pursuit, and officers who deploy or participate in Intervention/Termination techniques.

Instructions:

Date of Pursuit: Enter the date the pursuit occurred

Officer Name: Enter your name if you were at any time involved in the pursuit.

Call Sign: Enter your communication call sign. Ex: L4

<u>Vehicle #</u>: Enter the vehicle number

Vehicle Type: Enter the type of assigned vehicle. Ex: Marked Patrol Vehicle

If Other Vehicle Type, Describe: If you are driving an unmarked vehicle, etc.

Did Officer Advise Radio Communications of the Pursuit or Role in the Pursuit: Enter a Yes or No response.

Emergency Lights Activated: Did the Officer activate their emergency lights?

<u>Siren Activated</u>: Did the Officer activate their siren?

<u>If answered no, explain</u>: If the Officer did not activate their emergency lights or siren, the Officer should provide an explanation for not doing so.

Vehicle Equipped w/In-Car Camera: Yes or No response

Properly Working: Yes or No response

Pursuit Recorded: Yes or No response

<u>Audio Transmitted via In-Car Camera</u>: If the vehicle is equipped with an in-car camera system, did the in-car camera adequately capture the audio? Yes or No response.

<u>Properly Working</u>: Yes or No response

Audio Recorded: Yes or No response

<u>Recorded with Body Worn Camera</u>: If the Officer was issued a BWC, did the BWC record the pursuit? Yes or No response

Properly Working: Yes or No response

Pursuit Recorded: Yes or No response

<u>If answered no, explain</u>: If any of the recording equipment did not record the pursuit, the Officer shall provide an explanation.

Was the pursuit terminated by a supervisor, air service, or involved Officer? If yes, Name: Provide the name of the Officer or supervisor who terminated the pursuit.

<u>Why</u>: Provide an explanation for terminating the pursuit.

What was the nature or reason for initial contact: Traffic stop, pursuable offense, etc.

What offense did the Officer reasonably believe the suspect committed or the criminal offense the vehicle was involved in: Auto-Burglary, Robbery, Forcible Felony, etc.

What was the Officer's role: Primary/Initiating Officer, Assisting Officer, etc.

Time pursuit was initiated: Enter the time the pursuit started.

Location pursuit was initiated: Enter the location the pursuit started at.

<u>Grid</u>: Enter the grid the pursuit started in.

<u>Time pursuit ended</u>: Enter the time the pursuit concluded.

Location pursuit ended/terminated: Enter the location the pursuit concluded at.

<u>Grid</u>: Enter the grid the pursuit concluded at.

<u>Pursuit speeds</u>- Average: Enter the average speeds the suspect vehicle traveled at.

Highest speed attained: Enter the highest speeds the suspect vehicle traveled at.

<u>Traffic Conditions</u>: Enter the traffic congestion during the pursuit. Ex - Light Traffic- free-flowing.

Weather: Enter the conditions of the weather at the time of the pursuit.

<u>Neighborhood</u>: Enter the type of neighborhood the pursuit traveled through. Ex - residential, commercial, etc.

<u>Road Conditions</u>: Enter the road conditions at the time of the pursuit. Ex - Dry roads, wet roadways, etc.

Did this pursuit involve a traffic crash: Yes or No response

If Yes, was Risk Management notified: Yes or No response

Was a Vehicle Intervention Technique utilized to Prevent or Terminate this pursuit: Yes or No response

If Yes, identify the technique: Enter the type of Intervention Technique that was utilized.

Was a second technique utilized: Yes or No response

<u>Identify Officer's role in the Intervention Technique</u>: Enter your involvement in the intervention technique. Ex – Initiating Officer, Assisting Officer, etc.

Explain Your Participation in the Pursuit: Enter the details of the pursuit in a narrative format.
