Department of Children's Services INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF FORM CS-0651

Surrender in Tennessee of a child to Tennessee Department of Children's Services or Licensed Child Placing Agency

- 1. The following form is composed of five (5) parts making a complete package which must be used at the time of surrender of a child for adoption in a Tennessee court to a Licensed Child-Placing Agency (LPCA) or the Tennessee Department of Children's Services in these matters, (TDCS).
- 2. The Surrendering Party's Pre-Surrender Information Form and Accepting Party's Pre-Acceptance Information Form may be completed prior to the surrender in court. If the pre-surrender or pre-acceptance forms are completed prior to the surrender in court, they must be notarized.
- 3. The Tennessee Surrender Form and Acceptance by the Agency must be completed at the time of the surrender in court.
- 4. Copies of the Tennessee Surrender Form, Acceptance by Agency, Surrendering Party's Pre-Surrender Information Form, and Accepting Party's Pre-Acceptance Information Form should be given to the person executing the surrender, and to the Department or LPCA.
- 5. The Revocation of Surrender by a Parent or Guardian, which is part of the package, must be given to the parent or guardian at the time of the surrender.
- 6. The requirements for execution and processing of the forms are contained in T.C.A. § §36-1-111 and 36-1-112
- 7. The information in these forms is confidential and is not to be released without the written approval of the court.
- 8. The Redaction Application form at the end of this form only needs to be completed if the child is 5 months or less, and the biological parent wishes for their identifying information to be redacted. A copy of the completed redaction form needs to be provided to the biological parent.
