Department of Children's Services INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF FORM CS-0797

Affidavit of Reasonable Efforts

This affidavit should be used when a child first comes into care or is at risk of entering care. It describes to the court the efforts DCS made to prevent the removal of a child. It <u>may</u> also be used during reviews to describe the support the department has provided to help reunify the family.

Once a permanency plan has been developed and approved, staff <u>may</u> wish to use form <u>CS-0798</u>, titled simply, **Affidavit**.

Please be mindful that some courts also require a quarterly progress report, <u>CS-0430</u> for the review of permanency plan progress, so check with your regional counsel to determine the forms preferred by your local courts.

Note: According to TCA 37-1-166, an affidavit is to be filed with the court when the custody of a child is at issue; however this is not required when a child comes to the court's attention to answer to a delinquent charge.
