How to get a Tennessee State Photo ID for a Youth in Foster Care (For DCS staff only)

What do I take to the DMV?

1) State of Tennessee Photo Identification Justification Affidavit (completed by the DCS case worker or representative).

The affidavit for DCS employees does not require a social security number but does require the employees' job title and identification number. The purpose of the DCS affidavit is to allow a minor to make application for the identification license without requiring the DCS case worker or representative to assume financial liability for the minor.

- 2) Proof of US citizenship and/or legal presence (one of the following):
 - U.S. Birth Certificate
 - U.S. Passport
 - I-551/Permanent Resident Card
- 3) Proof of a social security number (if one has been issued)
- 4) Proof of Tennessee Residency
 - The affidavit will serve as the only proof of residency that is required
- 5) These IDs will be issued free of charge
- 6) A youth in DCS custody may be accompanied at the Drivers Services Center by a DCS case worker, provider case worker, or foster parent.
- 7) If the Affidavit is being used for the purpose of a license to operate a motor vehicle as a minor, the following Department of Safety and Homeland Security forms must also be completed; Minor/Teenage Affidavit and Cancellation Form
