2.354 BAIL BONDSMEN – BOUNTY HUNTERS

A. Officers will:

- 1. Assist bail bondsmen and bounty hunters by:
 - a. Attempting to serve confirmed arrest warrants consistent with 2.600 Arrest Procedures;
 - b. Standing by to preserve the peace and enforce any observed criminal law violations in the absence of warrants;

- c. Transport detainees only after:
 - (1) Verifying the identity of the bail bondsman or bounty hunter;
 - (2) Verifying the existence of a valid arrest warrant or court order of forfeiture for the detainee; and
 - (3) Obtaining known criminal history and background information from the bail bondsman or bounty hunter.
- 2. Complete reports for all incidents involving bail bondsmen or bounty hunters regardless if assistance was provided; and
- 3. Not enlist the aid of a bail bondsman or bounty hunter to assist as a police authority extension of this agency.

B. Supervisors will:

- 1. Respond to calls for assistance from bail bondsmen or bounty hunters; and
- 2. Recommend to the bail bondsman or bounty hunter that they obtain court orders of forfeiture or arrest warrants in appropriate cases.
