- A. Initial reports will contain all pertinent information that includes, but is not limited to the:
1. Victim information, injuries received, and medical treatment provided;
 2. Weapon and/or force used;
 3. Description of all items stolen;
 4. Description of crime scene processing, evidence collected, processed, and disposition;
 5. Suspect and vehicle descriptions, directions, etc.;
 6. Area canvassing performed to include personal identification information and addresses of all persons contacted and any information they provided;
 7. Investigative steps and results.
