Structured Decision Making

<u>Procedures Manual</u> – includes the Structured Decision Making policy and procedures for CPI report acceptance, agency response and response priority intake decision making. SDM decision trees for report acceptance do not revise current CPI policy. New policy includes reports with children age five or under; or, children age 6 through 10, or limited by disability without adequate supervision, food or shelter to be assigned for an Alternative Response with a three calendar day contact requirement. The manual is expected to be used in conjunction with Child Protection Investigation Part 4 policy for CPI intake.
