#### **4-1605 DEFINITION OF A MILITARY FAMILY**

A military family is any family in which at least one of the caretakers is a full-time active duty member with any one of the United States armed forces. A military family may live on the military base or in the civilian community. A family in which the caretaker is in part-time reserved forces would not be considered a military family for purposes of the child protection investigation.
