CSENet is a nationwide child support enforcement network that allows states to communicate electronically. This reduces the need for hard copy notifications and requests and allows information to be exchanged in a timely manner. \* A list of states that exchange information with Louisiana through CSENet may be located on the Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) webpage at: <http://www.acf.hhs.gov/programs/cse/newhire/csenet/contacts/states/louisiana.htm> \*\*

Use of the following screens will allow CSENet transactions to be sent and received:

- List CSENet Transaction (LICT) - Lists all sent and received transactions.
- CSENet Case Information (CSCI) - Provides payment and contact information for the state sending the transaction as well as other state case numbers.
- CSENet Absent Parent 1 (CAP1) - Displays NCP demographic information including previous addresses.
- CSENet Absent Parent 2 (CAP2) - Displays aliases, mother and father names, and employment and insurance information.
- CSENet Participants (CSPA) - Displays CP and child information.
- CSENet Court Order (CSCO) - Displays court order data including duration of debt and arrears.
- CSENet Request (CSRE) - Allows user to refer new cases and follow up on established interstate cases as well as request enforcement actions.
- CSENet Collection Data (CSCD) - Displays information relating to payments received from federal and state tax offsets and lottery intercepts.
