In order to develop better communication between states, UIFSA provides for specific timeframes:

Within 2 days, the responding state must notify the Initiating State:

- When written communication is received from the respondent or the respondent's attorney,
- When jurisdiction over the respondent cannot be obtained.

(The two days exclude Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays).

The **\* NCP \*\*** has 20 days from the date of mailing or personal service of a notice of registration to contest the validity of the enforcement.

Within 30 days of assuming CEJ and modifying a support order, the responding state must send a certified copy of that order to the **\* issuing \*\*** state which had CEJ over the earlier order, and to each tribunal in which the party knows that the earlier order had been registered.
