The Medical Eligibility Determination Team (MEDT) has been experiencing numerous problems with the completeness of forms as well as the quality of medical and social information forwarded by field staff for the disability and incapacity determination.

Effective immediately:

All AFDC applications or redetermination requiring an incapacity decision from the Medical Eligibility Determination Team (MEDT) require submission of a **complete** Form 90 package.

A complete package includes medical information on Forms 10-A, 10-B, 10-D or the MEDICAL REPORT section of Form 90; social information on the SOCIAL INFORMATION section of Form 90; and case identification information **including** the type of decision and period of coverage requested on Form 90-X. All available medical information shall be submitted with the package to allow the MEDT physicians to accurately determine if the incapacity criteria have been met.

Packages which are incomplete and do not allow for a decision by MEDT will be returned for correction and resubmission.
