### 519.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to describe the duties, selection, equipment and training of the Department's Part-Time Officer Program.

### 519.2 PART-TIME OFFICER PROGRAM

- A. The Department maintains a part-time sworn police officer program within Patrol. These officers function the same as full-time patrol officers. Part-time officers are required to adhere to all Department policies, procedures, and directives.
- B. All elements of the Part-Time Officer Program are under the ultimate control of the Chief of Police, who has control of appointments and dismissals.
- C. Part-time officers shall have all the powers and duties of regular full-time officers.
- D. Supervision received by part-time officers will be consistent with supervision of full-time patrol officers.
- E. Excluding educational requirements, the selection criteria relating to knowledge, skills, and abilities are the same as those for full-time officers.
- F. All part-time officers are required to complete, or have completed, a recruit academy training program comparable to that required for full-time officers, prior to any routine assignment in any capacity in which the part-time officer is allowed to carry a weapon or is in a position to make an arrest.
- G. Part-time officers will receive in-service training equivalent to that for full-time officers.
- H. Part-time officers are trained on the Department's Use of Force policies and tested for weapons

proficiency with the same frequency as full time officers.

- I. Part-time officers are provided with the same liability protection as that provided to full-time officers.
- J. Part-time officers shall receive annual performance evaluations as required for full-time officers. These requirements are outlined in GO 1007, Performance Management.
- K. Part-time officers shall meet all State requirements equivalent to full-time sworn personnel at the time of sworn appointment.
