### 107.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish an Oath of Office.

### 107.2 DEFINITION

Officer- All ranks of sworn personnel.

### 107.3 POLICY

It is the policy of the University of Chicago Police Department that all newly appointed officers shall take a sworn oath of office before assuming any official duties. University of Chicago Police Department officers shall abide by the oath of office. The newly appointed officer will sign an oath of office consistent to this general order and a copy of that oath of office will be placed into the officer's personnel file. The Chief of Police or their designee may administer the oath of office.

### 107.4 OATH OF OFFICE

The following shall be the oath of office:

I, \_\_\_\_\_, having been appointed a University of Chicago Police Officer, do solemnly swear and affirm that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of such to the best of my abilities and in full accord with the rules and regulations of The University of Chicago and its Department of Police.
