

## The Flag

### 1059.1 PRESENTATION OF THE FLAG

1. In conjunction with an official flag ceremony, or when the flag is passing in a parade or in review, or during rendition of the national anthem all members present shall stand at attention.
  - a. Sworn members in uniform will execute a military style hand salute, unless a public safety responsibility is present or required.
  - b. Sworn members in civilian attire will place their right hand over their heart.
  - c. Civilian staff in uniform or civilian attire will place their right hand over their heart.

### 1059.2 SALUTING

1. A military style hand salute should be performed by sworn members in uniform.
  - a. The right hand is raised until the tip of the forefinger touches the forehead slightly above the right eye. The thumb and fingers are extended and joined. The forearm is inclined to a 45-degree angle with the hand and wrist straight.

### 1059.3 PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

1. The Pledge of Allegiance should be rendered by standing at attention, facing the flag, and with the right hand over the heart.
  - a. Sworn members in uniform should remain silent, face the flag, and render the military style hand salute.
