Attempted Aggravated Murder, Murder, Attempted Murder, Aggravated Sexual Assault, Aggravated Assault resulting in serious bodily injury to another, Aggravated Kidnapping, Aggravated Arson, Aggravated Burglary, Aggravated Robbery, Felony Discharge of a Firearm, or a Felony Offense involving the use of a dangerous weapon if the minor has been previously adjudicated of a felony offense involving the use of a dangerous weapon.

^{**} Homicide/manslaughter/offenses involving loss of life will receive a unique Suggested Length of Stay based on; a) merits of the committing offense, b) Court recommendations, c) other factors.

^{**}Any Catagory B, C or D classification can have Aggravating or Mitigating factors attached to the Length of Stay.
