I. Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to define membership terms and conditions, leadership selection and charge of the Parking and Traffic Safety Committee.

II. Scope

This Policy applies institution-wide to all current and prospective members of the UT Health San Antonio Parking and Traffic Safety Committee.

III. Policy

The Parking and Traffic Safety Committee meets as necessary. Participation of student representatives is particularly important because students are more often largely affected by parking decisions than faculty and staff.

A. Charge

To serve in a consultative and advisory capacity to the President and Associate Vice President for Facilities, Safety and Risk Management, to review issues regarding traffic safety and parking and recommend resolutions, and to serve as an avenue of appeal in cases of dispute and exception.

B. Membership

1. One (1) faculty representative from the School of Health Professions
2. Two (2) faculty representatives from the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences
3. One (1) faculty representative from the School of Dentistry
4. Two (2) faculty representatives from the Long School of Medicine
5. One (1) faculty representative from the School of Nursing
6. Five (5) classified employees, one from each of the five Schools

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7. One (1) Health Science Center employee from any department, and
8. Ten (10) students, two (2) from each of the five Schools, one voting and one alternate.

C. Ex-Officio membership (with vote)

1. Manager, Learning and Leadership Development
2. One (1) employee representative from Marketing, Communications and Media or Web Initiatives

D. Ex-Officio membership (without vote)

1. Chief, University Policy

E. Chair

Designated annually by the President from the membership.

F. Term of Membership

Members serves on the Committee for a term up to three (3) years.

There are no defined terms used in this Policy.

VI. Review and Approval History
