## I. Purpose

To establish the responsibilities of the UT Health San Antonio Staff Advisory Council.

## III. Policy

#### A. Overview

The objective of the UT Staff Advisory Council (SAC) is to promote a positive and collaborative group of representatives who are committed to addressing the needs of UT Health San Antonio's (UTHSA)Administrative and Professional and Classified employees. The current council has fourteen work units made up of twenty-nine (29) individuals who represent non-faculty employees from all areas of UTHSA.

- B. The goals of the Staff Advisory Council (SAC) are:
  - 1. To serve as a representative advisory council for all non-faculty employees (staff).
  - 2. To provide a vehicle for communication of interest, concerns, and issues that affect staff at UTHSA campuses, including the South Texas campuses.
  - 3. To present recommendations to UTHSA President.
