I. Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to outline the charge of the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) to assure animal research conducted at the University is in compliance with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Animal Welfare Act and Regulations, Public Health Service (PHS) Policy, the Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (Guide) and Association for Assessment and Accreditation of Laboratory Animal Care (AAALAC) International standards.

II. Scope

This Policy applies institution-wide to all UT Health San Antonio (University) faculty, staff, and/or students conducting animal research activities, inclusive of the School of Medicine, the Dental School, the School of Nursing, the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, the School of Health Professions, centers, and organized research units.

III. Policy

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) is a faculty oversight committee appointed by the President to ensure that all programs concerning the care and use of laboratory animals at UT Health San Antonio are in compliance with federal and University rules and regulations.

A. Responsibilities

As stated in the charge to the IACUC, the IACUC is responsible for:

- 1. Assuring that the use of animals in research, teaching, and/or education is in accordance with institutional and federal guidelines.
- 2. Assisting the faculty whose research endeavors involve animals.
- 3. Reviewing the programs for the care and treatment of animals in all areas of the University at least semiannually to assess compliance with institutional and federal standards.

- 4. Reviewing all protocols advocating the use of animals in research, training, or education as needed, but at least annually.
- 5. Reviewing and advising on the occupational health program and the training program as needed, but a least on a semi-annual basis.

B. Federal Regulations

Federal regulations concerning the use of animals in research and education require that approval to conduct such activities be given by the IACUC regardless of funding before the work can commence. All protocols for the use of animals must be reviewed by the IACUC annually.
