Law Enforcement Funerals



CALEA Standards:

I. Purpose

The purpose of the directive is to set out procedures for Officers of the Wilmington Police Department, including those in ceremonial units, to participate/attend Law Enforcement Funerals.

II. Procedures

Funeral Attendance

Officers wishing to represent the Department at funerals or memorial services for Officers killed in the line of duty may do so under the following conditions:

- **A.** Officers voluntarily attend while off duty and in dress uniform.
- **B.** The services are within 150 miles of the City.
- **C.** One vehicle and fuel will be provided by the Department. No further expense will be borne by the Department or city.
- **D.** The Chief of Police may, at their discretion, modify this order to cover unusual circumstances.

Official Department Involvement in Funerals

The grid on the following page serves as a guideline to standardize services our agency will attempt to provide at funerals when requested to do so. Not every conceivable situation can be taken into account, and if instances arise which are not addressed in this chart, the Chief of Police maintains the authority to authorize any detail or preclude any detail at his/her discretion.
