To establish training guidelines for personnel authorized to use, set up and maintain the Mobile Command Center and to establish a list of equipment necessary for the operation and maintenance of the Mobile Command Center.

General Operation

28 29 30 The operations of the Mobile Command Center and its associated equipment shall be in accordance with all manufacturers' recommendations and training as provided by the agency.

31 32 The Administrative Services Division Commander shall keep all records pertaining to the Mobile Command Center equipment inventory, inspection and training.

The Administrative Services Division shall be responsible for training, operational control, maintenance of onboard computers and associated electronic equipment and the re-stocking of consumables within the Mobile Command Center. However; operators of the Mobile Command Center may be utilized from other Divisions within the Sheriff's Office.

• Equipment

- O A list of equipment necessary for the operation and maintenance of the Mobile Command Center shall be maintained by the Sheriff's office.
 - This equipment shall be inspected at least monthly to ensure that it is maintained in a state of operational readiness.
 - Only computer hardware and software approved by the Sheriff or Chief Deputy, in consultation with Sheriff's Office computer support personnel, will be used in the Mobile Command Center.
 - Under no circumstance shall computer hardware or software be used or installed that has not been approved by the Sheriff or his designee.
 - Software approved for use will only be installed by or under the supervision of Sheriff's Office computer support personnel.

- o Maintenance shall be in accordance with all manufactures' recommendations.
- The Mobile Command Center shall be inspected visually for damage before and after each deployment.
 - Any damage will be documented.
- A maintenance record shall be maintained for equipment associated with the Mobile Command Center.
- Vehicle chassis and powertrain maintenance records will be maintained by the York County Vehicle Maintenance Department.
- Maintenance, repair or replacement of radio communications equipment will be performed only by authorized personnel.
- o Maintenance, repair or replacement of computer and associated computer network equipment will only be performed by authorized personnel.
- No alterations will be made to the Mobile Command Center without authorization from the Sheriff or his designee.
- o Fluid levels of all motorized components, Engine and Generator(s) will be checked prior to operation and topped off as appropriate.
- o The fuel tank shall be topped off following each use.
- Any equipment failures during a deployment shall be reported to the Administrative Services Division Commander.

Training

- The Administrative Services Division Commander shall maintain a list of Sheriff's Office personnel trained in the use and operation of the Mobile Command Center.
- o All personnel prior to being authorized to operate the Mobile Command Center shall receive training as deemed appropriate by the Sheriff or his designee.
- o This training shall include at a minimum the following:
 - General operations.
 - Operational restrictions such as height clearances, etc.
 - Parking location considerations.
 - Generator operation.
 - Shore power operations.

Internal computer network set up and operations. 93 Monitor switch panel operations. 94 Radio operations. 95 Direct TV satellite receiver deployment and DTV operation. 96 Broadcast TV antenna operation and broadcast TV operation. 97 Troubleshooting. 98 99 Training shall be completed and documented for all individuals authorized to use or 100 operate the Mobile Command Center. 101 102 103 Staffing o The Mobile Command Center has a driver and passenger position as well as a 104 command area and a 4 station work area at the back of the unit. 105 When deployed, the Mobile Command Center will be staffed with a qualified 106 driver/operator who will be responsible for the following: 107 Selecting the most expedient route to use keeping in mind height restrictions. 108 Delivering and setting up the Mobile Command Center at the designated location. 109 Serving as access control and site security until relieved. 110 111 Breaking down the Mobile Command Center following the deployment and returning the unit to parking. 112 113 o Depending on the nature of the incident, the Mobile Command Center may also be 114 staffed by the following: 115 Rhodium Software operator, 116 Dispatcher or radio operator(s), 117 Scribe. 118 Public Information Officer. 119 Computer/Electronic Equipment support personnel, 120 Other security personnel, 121 Other personnel as deemed necessary by the Incident Commander or Command, 122 Staff member on scene. 123 124 125 Deployment o The Mobile Command Center is equipped with valuable tools and can provide 126 incident commanders a location to document and coordinate operations of a routine 127 128 and tactical nature. o The Mobile Command Center may be utilized for the following: 129 Special Events, 130

Administrative Services Division Commander along with the Division Commander of 149 150 the respective supervisor making the request. o The page/text shall include: 151 The nature of the incident. 152 The supervisor who is requesting the Mobile Command Center. 153 The location where the Mobile Command Center is requested. 154 155 The Administrative Services Division or Uniform Patrol Commander shall determine 156 and notify which qualified operator will deliver and operate the Mobile Command 157 Center. 158 o The assigned driver/operator shall determine the most expedient route to the scene 159 taking into consideration height and width obstacles when selecting the route. 160 161 Outside Agency Request for the Mobile Command Center 162 o Agencies and county departments, other than, the York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office 163 may request the use of the Mobile Command Center. 164 Outside agency requests will be handled as follows: 165 Request will be made and approved through the Sheriff or his designee. 166 The requestor will be asked to provide the following information: 167 ❖ The nature of the incident. 168 ❖ The location where the Mobile Command Center is to be delivered to. 169 ❖ The point of contact and/or name and rank of the Incident Commander. 170 171 ❖ Approximate amount of time the Mobile Command Center will be needed. 172 173 o Once approved, the Sheriff or his designee will notify either the Administrative Services Division Commander or Patrol Division Commander of the approval and the 174 point of contact for the requesting agency. 175 Page **4** of **5**

- Under no circumstances may an outside agency connect computer hardware to or install computer software on the Mobile Command Center computers or network without the express permission of the Sheriff or Chief Deputy.
- If the Sheriff or Chief Deputy approves of an outside agency to install software or hardware in the Mobile Command Center such installation shall be performed by York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office computer support personnel.
- The designated operator(s) shall remain with and assist in the operation of the Mobile Command Center until the Mobile Command Center is no longer needed, relieved by another qualified York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office operator or recalled by the Sheriff or his designee.
- Only the Sheriff or Chief Deputy may approve the Mobile Command Center be left with an outside agency without the presence of a York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office qualified operator.
- The designated operator shall document any damage done by the requesting agency as well as any consumables that need to be replaced.
 - Documentation of damage or consumables that need to be replaced shall be forwarded to the Administrative Division Commander.
