### Adding a new Program in PowerFTO?

- 1. Choose a <u>New Program to add</u>.
- 2. Decide to <u>use template or create from scratch</u>.
- 3. <u>Elect Program Coordinators</u> for new program.
- 4. <u>Decide on program setting adjustments (I.E., performance categories, forms, etc.)</u>





### **Permission Roles**



Site Administrator

Full access to program

Only users with full access to all programs and features



Program Coordinator

Complete Program Control

Can manage specific programs and add users to program.



### Supervisor

Can access forms in that stage

Can access forms in that stage.

Trainers

Access to forms in that stage.

Users will have access only over their trainees.

### Adding/Customizing Performance Categories

Program Coordinators and Site Admins can <u>add/customize</u> <u>a Performance category</u> – Program Settings>Performance>Add Performance Category

- The ratings tab will let you adjust the numerical rating for all categories.
- Headings can be added to group your performance categories.
- You can re-order by left clicking the ten-dot menu and dragging/dropping in place.

### **Adding/Customizing Skills**

Program Coordinators and Site Admins can add skills Program Settings>Skills>Add Skill

- Master list of skills is in site settings>site lists>skills.
- Program coordinators can pull in existing skills into the program OR create entirely new as needed.
- You can re-order by left clicking the ten-dot menu and • dragging/dropping in place.
