I. STATEMENT OF POLICY

To ensure that child support obligations are met, child support enforcement uses a variety of tools to encourage compliance with support orders. The primary method of enforcement is Income withholding (assignment). However, other enforcement actions outlined under 45 CFR 303.6 may be pursued to bring the case into compliance.

II. PROCEDURES

Enforcement actions include any of the following:

- Contact with the NCP, including office appointments, telephone contacts, notices mailed;
- Administrative and/or judicial liens against property owned by the NCP;
- Freezing and Seizure of assets/property;
- Suspension of business, professional, driver's, hunting, or fishing licenses;
- Interception of federal tax refund;
- Interception of state tax refund;
- Offset of winnings from the Louisiana Lottery; or progressive slot machine annuities;
- Reporting the delinquency to Credit Bureaus (This is the responding state's responsibility in UIFSA cases.)
- Contempt charges;
- Request another state to enforce the order under UIFSA.
- Administrative Offset
