Definition:

- State Law provides for the issuance of Louisiana AIDS Advocacy Network license plates for private passenger automobiles/vans, pickup trucks up to 16,000 lbs, and recreational vehicles (motor homes).

Eligibility:

- Any resident of Louisiana can apply for a Louisiana AIDS Advocacy Network license plate.

Requirements:

- The applicant must submit the following documentation:
 - A photocopy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed OR
 - If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, proper title documentation and fees must be submitted along with the request for the special plate.

Fees:

- \$25.00 annual royalty fee, in addition to regular registration fees, is due at initial issuance and all subsequent renewals.
- \$8.00 handling fee is due on all transactions except renewals.
- \$3.50 administrative handling fee is due only at initial issuance.
- \$3.50 fee is required to transfer the plate to another vehicle in the applicant's name.

Notes:

- Plates may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between owners.
- Based on availability, plates may be issued through any motor vehicle office or public tag agent location.
- Renewal transactions can be processed by any motor vehicle office, public tag agent or through the website at [expresslane.org](http://www.expresslane.org).
