**General:**

- This law provides for the issuance of a National Rifle Association license plate and provides revenues to the NRA Foundation, Inc. The funds shall be used solely for NRA Foundation, Inc. Louisiana Chapter. This license plate can be issued to private passenger automobiles, vans, private trucks up to 16,000 lbs., and private buses.

**Eligibility:**

- There are no eligibility requirements for the National Rifle Association license plate.

**Requirements:**

- Any citizen of Louisiana can be issued, upon application, a National Rifle Association license plate.
- A photocopy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed,  
OR
- If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, proper title documentation and fees must be submitted along with the request for the special plate.

**Fees:**

- \$60.00 - in addition to regular registration fees, due at initial issuance and all subsequent renewals.
- \$8.00 - handling fee due on all transactions except renewals.
- \$3.50 - administrative handling fee due only at initial issuance.
- \$3.00 - transfer the plate to another vehicle in the applicant's name.

**Notes:**

- Plates are available for immediate issuance through the Specialized Vehicle Unit.
- Plates may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between owners.

- All other transactions can be processed by any motor vehicle office or public tag agent.
