Definition:

- This law provides for the issuance of a Louisiana Seafood license plate and provides revenues to the Louisiana Seafood Promotion and Marketing Fund. The funds shall be used by the Louisiana Seafood Promotion and Marketing Fund to implement the duties and functions of that board, relating to the promotion and marketing of seafood. This license plate can be issued to private passenger automobiles, vans, private trucks up to 16,000 lbs, and private buses.

Eligibility:

- There are no eligibility requirements for the Louisiana Seafood license plate.

Requirements:

- Any citizen of Louisiana can be issued, upon application, the Louisiana Seafood license plate.
- A photocopy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed if the vehicle is currently registered. OR
- If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, proper title documentation and fees must be submitted along with the request for the special plate.

Fees:

- \$50.00 fee, in addition to regular registration fees, is due at initial issuance and all subsequent renewals.
- \$8.00 handling fee is due on all transactions except renewals.
- \$3.50 administrative handling fee is due only at initial issuance.
- \$3.00 fee is required to transfer the plate to another vehicle in the applicant's name.

Notes:

- Plates may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between owners.
- Initial requests must be mailed to the Office of Motor Vehicles, Specialized Vehicle Unit, P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA 70896. All other transactions can be processed by any motor vehicle office or public tag agent.
