General:

- Laos War Veteran license plates may be issued to any veteran who served in the Laos War between July 1, 1961 and July 1, 1978.¹
- These license plates can be issued to automobiles, vans, private trucks up to 16,000 lbs., and motor homes.¹
- Credit will not be allowed for a valid plate currently on the vehicle when the special plate is issued, due to the plate being a free plate.
- Plates may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between owners.

Requirements:

- Applicant must submit their discharge papers indicating service time during the Laos War dates indicated above.
- A photocopy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed, if the vehicle is currently registered.
 - If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, all [necessary documentation](#) required for titling of the vehicle must be submitted along with the request.
- To apply for a special plate, you may do one of the following:
 - Apply through the Specialized Vehicle Unit (P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA 70896) for immediate issuance.
 - Apply at any [field office](#). Immediate issuance is based on availability at that office.
 - View and order specialty license plate on [Expresslane.org](http://www.Expresslane.org). Specialty plate will be mailed once the application is received and processed by the Office of Motor Vehicles.

Fees:

- This is a free, lifetime plate.
- \$10.00 - Replacement fee due for a lost or stolen plate
- \$8.00 - Handling fee due on all transactions
- \$3.00 - Transfer of the plate to another vehicle
