General:

- This law provides for the issuance of a special license plate for members of the Marine Corps League. This license plate can be issued to private passenger automobiles, vans, private trucks up to 16,000 lbs., motor homes.

Eligibility:

- Any veteran of the United States Marine Corps who is a member of the Marine Corps League is eligible for this type plate.

Requirements:

- Proof of membership in the Marine Corps League.
- The plate can be used upon personally owned or jointly owned vehicles that are registered in the applicant's name.
- A photocopy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed if the vehicle is currently registered. OR
- If the vehicle is not registered, proper title documentation and fees must be submitted along with the request for the Marine Corps League license plate.

Fees:

- Regular renewal fees apply.
- \$25.00 - one-time fee, in addition to regular registration fees, due at initial issuance.
- \$8.00 - handling fee due on all transactions except renewals.
- \$3.00 - transfer the plate to another vehicle in the applicant's name.

Notes:

- Plates may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between owners.
- Plates are available for immediate issuance through the Specialized Vehicle Unit.
- Initial requests must be mailed to the Office of Motor Vehicles, Specialized Vehicle Unit, P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA 70896. All other transactions can be processed by any motor vehicle office or public tag agent.
