General:

- Louisiana law allows for the issuance of World War II Veteran license plates. These plates are issued to private passenger automobiles, vans, private trucks up to 16,000 lbs., and motor homes.

Eligibility:

- Any citizen of Louisiana who was a member of the U.S. Armed Forces or of the Coast Guard who served in World War II is eligible for this type plate.

Requirements:

- All applications for the World War II license plate must be accompanied by a copy of a DD214 form which indicates service in World War II.
- The plate must be returned to the Department upon the death of the applicant.

Fees:

- The fee for the license plate is the same as regular registration fees.
- The renewal fee is regular registration fee only.
- \$8.00 - handling fee due on all transactions except renewals.
- \$3.00 - to transfer the plate to another vehicle.

Notes:

- This plate may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between motor vehicle owners.
- All requests for initial issuance of the special plate must be mailed to the Specialized Vehicle Unit, Headquarters, P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA 70896. All other transactions can be processed at any motor vehicle office or public tag agent.
