General

• The Purple Heart Recipient license plates are issued for private passenger automobiles/vans, private use trucks up to 16,000 lbs., private buses, and motorcycles.

Eligibility:

- Any recipient of the Purple Heart is eligible for this type plate. A plate may be issued for each vehicle registered in the recipient's name.
- The surviving spouse of a Purple Heart license plate holder may retain the plate, as long as the surviving spouse is not remarried.
 - If the Purple Heart recipient holds more than one plate at the time the Purple Heart recipient dies, the surviving spouse may determine which special license plates he/she wishes to retain.
- The plate must be returned to Office of Motor Vehicles in the event of the death or remarriage of the spouse.

Required Documentation:

- A copy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed.
 - If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, all <u>necessary</u> <u>documentation</u>.
- Photocopy of a DD214 form or any other military document that indicates the applicant was issued a Purple Heart.

Fees:

- This is a free, lifetime plate.
- \$10.00 Replacement fee for a lost or stolen plate
- \$8.00 Handling fee (due on all transactions)
- \$3.00 Transfer the plate to another vehicle

Notes:

- Credit will not be allowed when the special plate is issued, since the plate is free.
- Based on availability, plates may be issued through any Motor Vehicle field office or public tag agent location.
