**Policy 25.01 Shriner License Plates for Private Vehicles**

**General:**

- State Law provides for the issuance of Shriner license plates for private vehicles. These plates are issued to private passenger autos, minimum use trucks/vans, motorcycles, and private buses. The special license plates shall contain the Shrine symbol.

**Eligibility:**

- Any member in good standing with a Shrine organization is eligible for this type plate.

**Requirements:**

- Proof of status as a member in good standing with a Shrine organization.
- A photocopy of the registration certificate of the vehicle on which the plate will be placed.  
OR
- If the vehicle is not registered in the applicant's name, proper title documentation and fees must be submitted along with the request for the special Shriner license plate.

**Fees:**

- \$25.00 - in addition to regular registration fee, due at initial issuance.
- Regular renewal fee applies.
- \$8.00 - handling fee due on all transactions except renewals.
- \$3.50 - administrative handling fee due only on initial issuance.
- \$3.00 - to transfer the plate to another vehicle in the applicant's name.

**Notes:**

- Plates are available for immediate issuance through the Specialized Vehicle Unit.
- Plates may be transferred from one vehicle in applicant's name to another vehicle in applicant's name, but cannot be transferred between owners.
- Initial requests must be mailed to the Office of Motor Vehicles, Specialized Vehicle Unit, P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA 70896. All other transactions can be processed by any motor vehicle office or public tag agent.
