**Definition:**

- State Law provides for the issuance of an antique or antique prestige license plate to be used on a motorized or non-motorized World War II or Korean War military vehicle.

**Eligibility:**

- Any motorized or non-motorized World War II or Korean War military vehicle which has been restored to its original condition without modifications contrary to stock specifications.

**Notes:**

- An antique license plate issued to this vehicle prior September 1, 1996, shall remain a lifetime plate.

**Requirements:**

- An application for initial issuance or transfer of the plate must be accompanied by:
  - A completed Antique Plate Affidavit [DPSMV1911](#) form
  - A membership card in an antique car club OR a notarized statement attesting to the fact that the vehicle has been restored to its original condition without modifications contrary to stock specifications.
  - A photograph of the vehicle showing it is a World War II or Korean War military vehicle.

**Fees:**

- \$25.00 one-time fee is required for the antique license plate issued after September 1, 1996, for these military vehicles in addition to the regular registration fees.
- \$8.00 handling fee is due on all transactions except for renewals.
- \$3.00 fee is required to transfer the plate to another vehicle.

**Notes:**

- Duplicate titles and title corrections can be processed in any field office.
- All other requests must be forwarded to the Special/Dealer License Plate Unit, Headquarters.
