Requirements:

- All applicants eligible for a Social Security number (SSN) must provide their assigned number when applying for a driver's license or identification card.¹
 - Those with alien status that are ineligible for a Social Security number must provide a letter from the Social Security Administration stating they are *"ineligible"* or *"have not been issued"*.
 - The Office of Motor Vehicles will use a Social Security online verification system (SSOLV) for name changes for **all** applicants. The applicant's name must be changed with the Social Security Administration prior to making application at the Office of Motor Vehicles.
 - Name changes are not updated for at least 24 hours in the Social Security database.
 - The Social Security number is required from all U.S. male citizens or immigrants age 15 to 26, who apply for a driver's license or identification card in accordance with the Military Selective Service Act. Failure to provide the Social Security number will result in the denial of issuance.²
