

Section: 2. Driver's License Laws

Effective Date: 10/28/1986

General:

- The Department does not routinely suspend for Frequent Violators. However, Act 392 of the 1983 Legislative Session allows the Department to recognize a bond forfeiture as a conviction.
- Any suspension imposed prior to this date for Frequent Violations will be recalled and removed from the driving record.
- A letter must be directed to the individual advising that the suspension is being recalled and that the Department will continue to evaluate the driving record with regards to the Habitual Offender Law.
