Definition:

 The Department will suspend the license of any person that fails to pay child support and the Department receives a court order or request from the Department of Social Services (Support Enforcement).

Requirements:

- An indefinite suspension will be added and the license will be suspended until compliance is received from the court or from the Department of Social Services (Support Enforcement).
- Partial Compliance
 - The court may issue an order of partial compliance authorizing the issuance of a temporary operator's license if the court is satisfied that an undue financial hardship will occur or has occurred as a result of the operator's license suspension.
 - Department of Social Services may submit a Partial Compliance Release Certificate, partial compliance and the \$60.00 reinstatement fee in addition to any fee due for other statutory requirements (Act 613 2012 Legislation)

Fees:

• \$60 reinstatement fee in addition to any fee owed for other statutory requirements
