**General:**

- The Department will suspend the license of any person who has failed to attend and/or furnish proof to the court that they have attended an Operation Lifesaver Course for Safe Driving within one-hundred-eighty (180) days following the date of conviction for a railroad crossing signal or warning device violation.

**Requirements:**

- Serve mandatory 30 day suspension period.

**Fees:**

- \$60 reinstatement fee in addition to any fee owed for other statutory requirements
