Definition:

- An out-of-state affidavit is an order of suspension from another state issued to a Louisiana resident who failed to satisfy the ticket prior to the court date.

• **Type of Citation Accepted -** All **traffic** related violations will be accepted as out of state violations.

Compliance

• Final disposition from the court issuing the citation.

Fees:

• A \$60 reinstatement fee in addition to any fee owed for other statutory requirements.
