General:

- Upon receipt of a court order, the department will suspend the driving privileges of a
 person who has been convicted of purchasing or possessing alcohol while under the age
 of 21, or of a person who has been convicted of purchasing alcohol on behalf of a
 person under the age of 21.
- The court may issue an order which authorized the department to issue a restricted (hardship) license. Restrictions will be determined by the court.

Compliance:

- The violator must serve the 180 suspension period
- \$60 reinstatement fee
