General:

- State statute provides for the issuance of a certificate of title for an antique, classic, or vintage vehicle when there is no current record of ownership on which to base the issuance of a new title. This would apply to vehicles twenty-five (25) years old or older.

Requirements:

- A completed vehicle application form (DPSMV 1799).
- Affidavit of physical inspection. The physical inspection must be performed by a full-time Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) certified law enforcement officer who has been certified by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, to inspect motor vehicles.
- Notarized bill of sale
- Statement from applicant attesting to his membership in an organized automobile club
- Fees and sales/use taxes as applicable
- This procedure is only to be used when NO current record of ownership can be determined. If the current owner information is determined, the applicant must follow the normal titling procedure for vehicles.
