General:

• The Office of Motor Vehicles shall establish procedures by which licensed motor vehicle dealers may obtain a special handicapped license plates. The special handicapped dealer license plates shall be issued in lieu of dealer plates and in addition to any handicapped license plate issued for mobility impaired persons. Any vehicle bearing a special handicapped dealer license plate shall be operated by or for the benefit of a mobility impaired person. This plate type may be used on automobiles and trucks.

Eligibility:

 The dealer must have a current dealer number from the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission or from the Motor Vehicle Commission.

Requirements:

- Each dealer shall make a new application and pay the fee for the special handicapped license plate each time he desires to have such handicapped plate issued to him.
- The dealer shall present a statement attesting that the vehicle will be used solely by or for the benefit of a mobility impaired person.
- Once the dealer obtains special handicapped license plates, he shall be given priority on these plates for subsequent years that he makes timely and appropriate application.

Notes:

 This plate may be transferred from one vehicle to another for the use and benefit of a mobility impaired person.

Fees:

 A fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be assessed for each special handicapped dealer license plate issued.
