Section: 5. Motor Vehicle License Plate Classifications & Requirements

Effective Date: 08/02/1993

Revised Date: 12/27/1994

General:

- In accordance with the above statute and resolution, the plates listed under Categories 1 and 2 are subject to the new uniform identifiable license plate concept as it relates to the color and design of the plate.
- **Category #1**
 - These plates contain the color scheme of blue letters and numbers on a white background with the word "Louisiana" appearing in script at the top center of the plate in the color of red and the words "Sportsman's Paradise" appearing in blue block letters centered at the bottom of the plate.

- **Category #2**
 - These plates contain the color scheme of blue letters and numbers on a white background with the word "Louisiana" appearing in script at the top center of the plate in the color of red and a word or words signifying the special designation of such plates appearing in blue block letters centered at the bottom of the plate.
