Definitions:

 Sticker Inventory - The sticker inventory determines which sticker months can be sold beginning on the first of each month.

Procedures

- Stickers for Staggered Plates
 - o January November, December, January, February and March
 - o February December, January, February, March and April
 - o March January, February, March, April and May
 - o April February, March, April, May and June
 - o May March, April, May, June and July
 - o June April, May, June, July and August
 - o July May, June, July, August and September
 - o August June, July, August, September and October
 - September July, August, September, October and November
 - o October August, September, October, November and December
 - o November September, October, November, December and January
 - o December October, November, December, January and February
 - Example: Month of September stickers can be sold from July 1 through November 30.

• Stickers for Non-Staggered Plates

- Non-staggered plates, except ident trailer plates, must be issued one-year stickers which expire in June. Ident trailer plates can be issued either one-year or four-year stickers which expire in June or permanent stickers.
- One-year June stickers can be sold from May 1st of the year prior to the expiration date shown on the sticker until the following April 30th. Four-year June stickers can be sold from May 1st, four years prior to the expiration date shown on the sticker until April 30th of the year shown on the sticker.
- Example: One-year June 2001 stickers and four-year June 2004 stickers can be sold from May 1, 2000 through April 30, 2001.
- Permanent stickers can be sold at any time.
