General:

- Wheelchair lifts, when prescribed by a physician or licensed chiropractor, will be exempt from 5% state sales tax. All applicable parish and municipality taxes must be collected on the wheelchair lift, in addition to the taxes charged on the purchase price of the vehicle.
- The exemption is limited to the wheelchair lift (materials and labor) and not to any devices or major modifications such as hand controls, roof modifications, seat removal, etc.

Requirements:

- Vehicle Application (<u>DPSMV 1799</u>), completed and signed
- Original title or Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO), properly assigned
- Itemized bill of sale or dealer's invoice
 - The sale price of the wheelchair lift must be listed separately on the bill of sale or dealer invoice.
- Prescription from a physician or licensed contractor for the wheel chair lift.
 - The vehicle must be titled in the person's name, as shown on the physician or licensed chiropractor's prescription in order to receive the exemption.
 - If not titled in the individual's name listed on the prescription, a Designation of Mobility Impaired License Plate form (<u>DPSMV4222</u>) must be submitted.
