Definitions:

- Antique Vehicle A vehicle that is 25 years or older
- **Certificate of Destruction -** A type of title issued for a vehicle that meets the following requirements:
 - A water-damaged vehicle, other than an antique vehicle or a vehicle in excess of 20,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR)
 - A vehicles who's power train, computer, or electrical system has been damaged by flooding, as the result of a governor-declared disaster or emergency and has been declared a "total loss".¹
- **Total Loss** A motor vehicle that has sustained damages equivalent to 75% or more of the market value, as determined by the most current JD Power Guide.

General:

- A motor vehicle that has been issued a *Certificate of Destruction* shall **not** be²:
 - Issued a Salvage or Reconstructed Title²
 - Issued a Permit to Dismantle²
 - Registered for use on the roads or highways²
- A motor vehicle that has been issued a *Certificate of Destruction* shall **not** be resold as a retail unit. The vehicle shall be dismantled, sold for any usable parts, or crushed.²
 - When a water-damaged vehicle has been crushed or scrapped, the owner shall surrender the *Certificate of Destruction* to the Office of Motor Vehicles with the word "recycled" written or stamped across its face. A certificate of title of any type shall **not** be issued again for the vehicle.²
- The *Certificate of Destruction* may only be reassigned up to two times prior to dismantling or destruction of the motor vehicle.¹

Requirements:

- An insurance company that acquires ownership of a vehicle **must** apply for a *Certificate of Destruction* within thirty (30) days. The following must be submitted:²
 - Current Louisiana or out-of-state, properly assigned title (if applicable)
 - A completed Vehicle Application (<u>DPSMV1799</u>) form. "Certificate of Destruction" must be written or stamped on the front page of the application and on the face of the accompanying title.
 - A copy of the total loss settlement indicating the date of loss and the date of settlement
 - A completed Disclosure of Salvage/Reconstructed/Water Damaged/Hail Damaged Vehicle form (<u>DPSMV1637</u>).³
- An insurance company may apply for a *Certificate of Destruction* for a vehicle that has been damaged to the extent it is deemed a "total loss", even if the damage sustained to the vehicle did not result from a governor-declared disaster.
 - If the insurance company elects to apply for a *Certificate of Destruction* in lieu of a salvage title, a statement indicating this must be added to the proof of loss documentation and submitted with the file.
- One (1) replacement *Certificate of Destruction* may be issued if the original is lost. A replacement *Certificate of Destruction* can only be issued by the Specialized Vehicle Unit. The following must be submitted with the paperwork:
 - A completed Vehicle Application (<u>DPSMV1799</u>) form. The words "Certificate of Destruction" must be written or stamped on the application.
 - The *Duplicate Title Affidavit* section must also be completed **and** notarized by the insurance company.
 - A copy of the total loss settlement indicating the date of loss and the date of settlement
